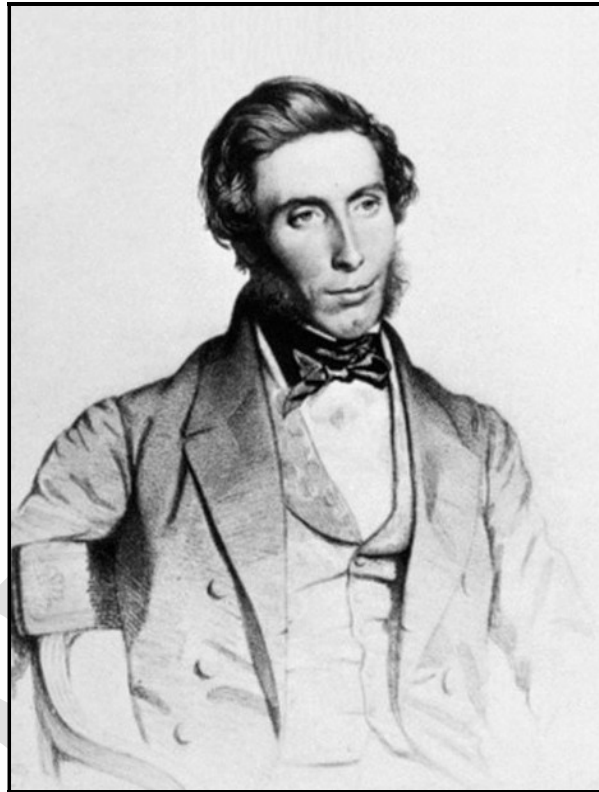

## *Invited Speakers*

---



Prof. Milind V. Kirtane received his M.S. degree in ENT from Seth G.S. Medical College and King Edward Memorial Hospital, Mumbai, India. He is a Consulting ENT Surgeon at P. D. Hinduja National Hospital and Medical Research Centre, Mumbai, Breach Candy, Cumballa Hill, and Saifee hospitals, Mumbai. He is also a Hon. Surgeon at King Edward Memorial Hospital and Professor Emeritus at Seth G.S. Medical College, Mumbai. Dr. Kirtane has a special interest in cochlear implants, endoscopic sinus surgery, and neurotology. He has performed over 2300 cochlear implant procedures and is credited with the first performance of such a procedure in India. Prof. Kirtane was the 2005 winner of the B.C. Roy Award, the highest honour given to doctors by the Indian government.



Prof. Chris de Souza trained at the University of Minnesota and completed his externship in otology and neurotology at Baptist Hospital in Nashville, Tennessee, before returning to India to further his training. In 1995, he was the second person in the world to be awarded the Orbit Silver Medal for his work on the nose, paranasal sinuses, and skull base. Dr. de Souza has published extensively in internationally peer-reviewed journals and several of his publications are considered landmark papers. He has published 18 postgraduate ENT medical textbooks in India, Germany, and the USA.



Mr. Steven Powell graduated with distinction from Newcastle University in 2001. He undertook both basic surgical training and higher surgical training in otolaryngology in the North-East, developing a specialist interest in paediatric ENT. He furthered his paediatric training during a one-year fellowship at the Royal Children's Hospital in Melbourne, Australia. His main specialist interest is the management of children with airway disorders. Mr. Powell is part of the paediatric airway multi-disciplinary team and lead for paediatric ENT at the Great North Children's Hospital.



Prof. Wytske J. Fokkens is a Professor at the Department of Otorhinolaryngology at the Academic Medical Center in Amsterdam. Her main focuses are sinus/skullbase surgery and mucosal pathology of the upper and lower airways. She is the secretary general of the European Rhinologic Society and Chairman of the European Position Paper on Rhinosinusitis and Nasal Polyps (EPOS). Dr. Fokkens is a member of the executive committee of ARIA and the author of more than 350 papers on rhinology and allergy. She is the author of the textbook *Rhinology and Skull Base Surgery, From the Lab to the Operating Room – An Evidence Based Approach*.
