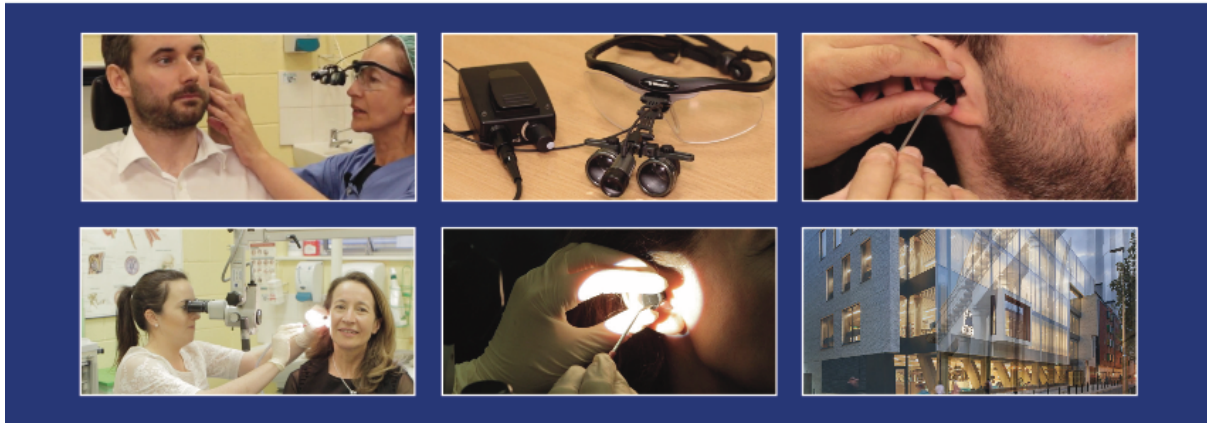




# Sharing Expertise in ENT (CPD accredited)



A series of seminars, covering the broad scope of ENT practice, as it relates to primary care, will be hosted at the RCSI **commencing in February 2018**

The programme will serve, as an update in ENT practice, for patient management and referral pathways, in primary care.

The seminars will be delivered by experts in the speciality of ENT and general practice. The National Lead for ENT Education in Primary Care, Ms Camilla Carroll will moderate the sessions.
